Verse 4

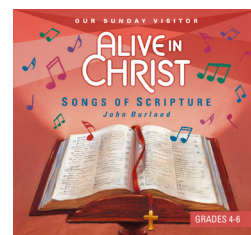
We are now his disciples called to witness everywhere.

Verse 3

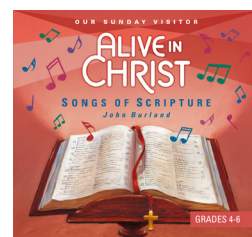
So Abraham and Sarah, too,

Verse 7

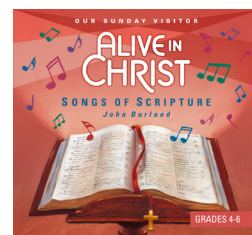
He cleaned his wounds and he gently picked him

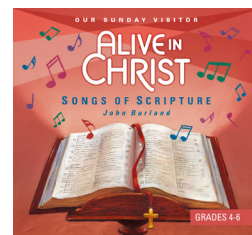
*Blessed are the peacemakers,

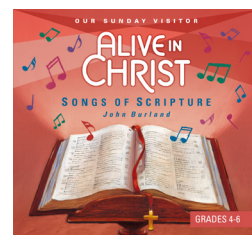

Verse 2

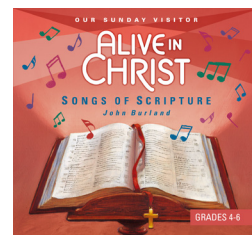
When you live with charity and justice

Siloam.”

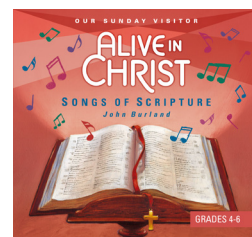
I raised my head, saw Jesus, the great “I
