How They Understand the Holy Family When children at this level hear that Jesus was once a child their age, it's natural for them to picture him in a family very much like their own. Just like they need someone to take care of them as they grow, so did Jesus. And it's important for them to realize that even Jesus had to listen to his mom and dad and follow their rules. Make these important connections to show your child that Jesus was like them in all things except he did not sin.


Who was the person who had the most influence in your life?

"The Christian home is the place where children receive the first proclamation of the faith. For this reason the family home is rightly called 'the domestic church,' a community of grace and prayer, a school of human virtues and of Christian charity" (CCC, 1666).
