CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand God's Kingdom Children at this age are familiar with stories, such as fairy tales, that involve kings and kingdoms, and they might think of Jesus' references to the Father's Kingdom in these terms. You can help your child understand that Christians cooperate with God to help God's Kingdom grow "on earth as it is in Heaven." We will live forever with God in his Kingdom in Heaven, but we also actively work to help God's Kingdom grow by showing love to one another.



CONSIDER THIS >>>

Without using words, how do we show our children that we love them?

Actions speak louder than words. Making a favorite meal, catching a ball, or wiping away tears as you put on a bandage are all signs of your love. We make God's life and love present with our words, attitudes, and actions—we manifest God's Kingdom. "The proclamation of the Kingdom of God was fundamental to Jesus' preaching. The Kingdom of God is his presence among human beings calling them to a new way of life as individuals and as a community... It is the Good News that results in love. justice and mercy for the whole world" (USCCA, p. 79).

- Talk about people who bring peace or share God's love in their daily lives.
