How They Understand Making Good Choices Children this age often define good choices in terms of the parameters they have been given by people they trust. These parameters are often specific to place or situation. Because children this age depend a great deal on social expectations, it's important that this early conscience formation occur in family environments that are trustworthy and supportive of Catholic moral values.



CONSIDER THIS >>>


Who in your life do you trust to give you good advice?

We are careful about who we trust to give us advice. We realize that even those we trust can be wrong because of our limitedness as human beings. "Wisdom enables us to see the world from God's viewpoint, which can help us come to grasp the purpose and plan of God. It grants us the long-range view of history, examining the present in the light of the past and the mystery of the future. It saves us from the illusion that the spirit of the times is our only guide" (USCCA, p. 208).
