How They Understand the Sacraments of Initiation

Most children this age do not remember their Baptism because it happened when they were babies. Because of this, they might miss the idea of conversion as applied to Christian Initiation. It is helpful for them to know the promises their parents made when they were baptized and how they can choose to "live out" their Baptism as children of God.

We can all think of a life-changing event or two in our lives. Spiritual conversion is truly life-changing. It is a turning away from sin and moving toward deeper union with God. As Catholics, we know that "sin harms our relationship with God. and damages our communion with the Church. Conversion of heart is the beginning of our journey back to God. ...Conversion must involve a change of heart as well as a change of actions" (USCCA, p. 237).
