Your family sponsors a child who lives in poverty. Which Corporal Works of Mercy are in action here? Name two.


Which Corporal Work of Mercy do churches show when they have a funeral for a loved one who passed?

## The Wedding at Cana

Jesus' friends were running out of wine at their wedding feast. That would have been really embarrassing. Jesus' mother noticed the wine running low and asked her son to help.

Do you help cheerfully?

What is one way you could help someone at school or work who's in an embarrassing situation?

## Jesus washes feet

Jesus washed his friends' feet because they were dusty, but mostly because he wanted to do something kind for them.

How do you feel when you do something kind for someone?

Can you think of someone who needs some extra love right now, and you could do something kind for them?

*Matthew 8:1-4*

## Jesus Lays Hands on a Leper

Don't you love living with your family?  
What if one of you had to go away and not come anywhere near you? Jesus understood how awful that must have been for those people.

What are some things that are important to you and you *need* the people in your family to be part of?

How can we show love to people who don't feel like they belong?

*Matthew 6:12-14*

## Forgive us our trespasses

Jesus us taught us, in the Lord's Prayer, to ask God to forgive our trespasses as we forgive others.

What are trespasses?

Why is it hard sometimes to forgive someone?
